General Manager Report: Palmer Advantage allows members to play for cart fees at other courses such as Skyline in Tucson. Tee times will normally be restricted to after 12:30 PM. Same will apply to people playing at Prescott Lakes.

Director of Golf Report: John Gunby was not present. Disabled Veterans day. Short discussion about teaching etiquette to existing members. Suggestion to have a demonstration of bunker raking, green repair, tee boxes, driving range, etc by assistant pro on a Saturday. Position in appropriate location on the course during play. Dave will talk to John Gunby.

Golf Course Superintendant Report: Will start changing pin locations 5 to 6 times per week shortly. Walk mow the greens 3 times a week, triplex mow 3 times a week and roll on Sundays. Deep tine of greens went well. Putting green only was verticut and had grass seed applied. Two applications have been sprayed on all the greens to help with poa seed heads. Will have a dedicated cup setter to help with good pin locating. Drains for greens are being cleaned out. Will be doing some fairway contouring with the mowers. Bunkers are being groomed.

Old Business: Smoking on the range and putting green has been addressed by John Gunby, nothing more will be done at this time.

New Business: Beverage cart days are dependant on revenue. They track purchases and eliminate the beverage cart on days that lose \$100 or so a day. New guest rate was put into place. Also raised rate for non golf Club members. Hope to encourage new golf memberships. Rates are still competitive for the area. New awnings for entrance to pro shop and meeting room are coming.
