2. Greg's report:
 - Results of the member survey are available on the website; two printed copies of all responses are available for review in the Activity Center.
 - Pickle ball courts are on schedule for a June 18th opening.
 - Men's shower renovation: the company is acquiring supplies and will provide a start date, Greg will send out an email one week prior to start to advise showers will be closed for about one month.
 - The Club met financial obligations during first five months; Food and Beverage very busy, private events going well. Monte Carlo night was successful and seen as positive event for club although high overhead. 70 people participated.
 - The next Party on the Patio will be June 21.
 - June 15 the Grille and ballrooms will be closed for the second of four special events this year that will close those facilities. A buffet will be served at the pool again. Eighteen weddings are scheduled so far for next year.
 - The golf course is in great shape, Brian and staff recognized for their good work.
 - The Board of Governors approved the names The Grille at Prescott Lakes, Terrace at Prescott Lakes, and the ballrooms as Fairway Room and Waterfall Room.
3. John thanked Greg for his quick response contacting a party interested in arranging a special event.
4. Mishael's report:
 - Membership is currently at 405, which will cover the expected attrition for June. Goal is to try to continue to stay ahead of attrition.
 - Currently 15 social members, some are upgrading to golf and others are bringing in new golfers.
5. Mission Statement and Objectives were reviewed. Committee was acknowledged for developing them quickly. John will present them to the Policy Committee and Board of Governors for review and approval.

6. Welcome Packets were distributed and reviewed. All aspects of the club are included in each packet.
7. Ambassador assignments reviewed. Many new members are out of town or in the process of moving, but many welcome dinners and golf outings have occurred with positive feedback.
8. Non-golf members have asked for a chance to tour the golf course, Greg will try to coordinate with the neighborhood parties, possibly look at a way for interested members to sign up in the Activity Center. Several Ambassadors volunteered to assist with tours.
